- Well-spoken, advanced level of English and confident in public situations
- Interest and/or background in helping children with learning disabilities
- We will ask you to volunteer for a 4 hour shift at least once per month, though additional shifts are available
- Be able to present one piece of ID that has been issued by the government of Canada which displays your name, date of birth, signature and photo. This information is required in order to complete a Criminal Record Check application via the Criminal Records Review Program (CRRP).
